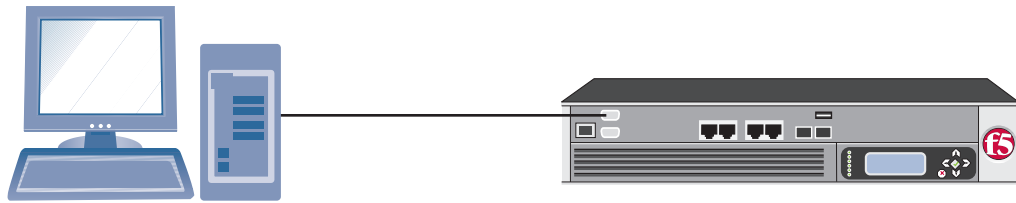

1 Connect a PC to the console port. Use the provided serial cable to connect from your PC to the port in the front of the unit marked "console."



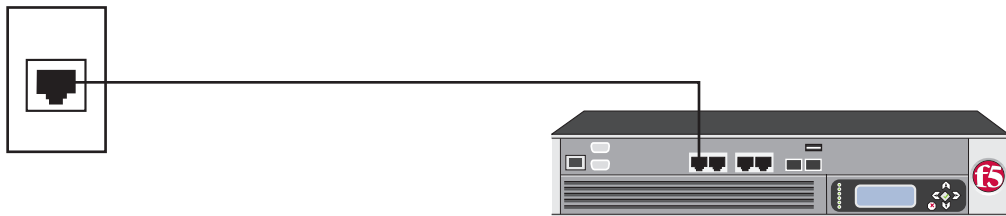
2 Start up your PC's terminal emulation software, and set the serial parameters to: 19200, n, 8, 1.

3 Connect the power and turn on the unit using the main power switch.

4 Log in as **root** using the provided password: [K@A167bC?](#).

5 Run the `/ts/install/tsconfig.pl` command, follow the prompts, and provide the requested information for your network and administrative settings.

6 Connect interface 1.1 (eth0) to your local Ethernet network.



Note: This is a 10/100/1000 connection.

You can now connect to the TrafficShield security application from any PC with a web browser that is on the network you established (in step 5) as allowed to manage this system.

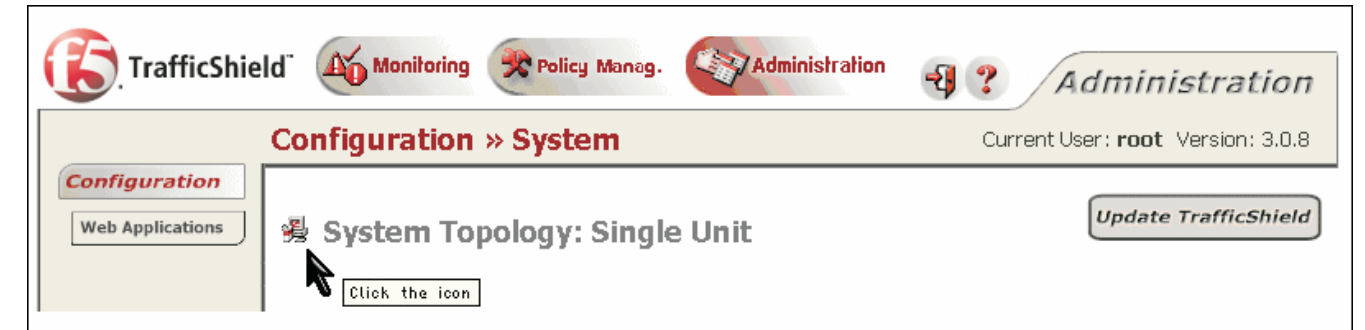
7 Connect from your PC's web browser to the permanent IP address or to the private IP address that you configured during Step 5.

For example: `https://192.168.1.100:1043/`

8 Log in with the account and password that you created in step 5.

9 The configuration wizard should start automatically.

If the wizard does not start, click the icon shown below to start it.



10 Follow the wizard's prompts, and enter the required information.

Note: The TrafficShield unit automatically restarts when you are done with this wizard.

11 Activate your license.

You do this in the Administration -> License screen.

Note: Your PC needs access to the Internet to complete the licensing process.

12 To continue configuring your TrafficShield system, click Administration -> Web Applications, and create your first web application.
